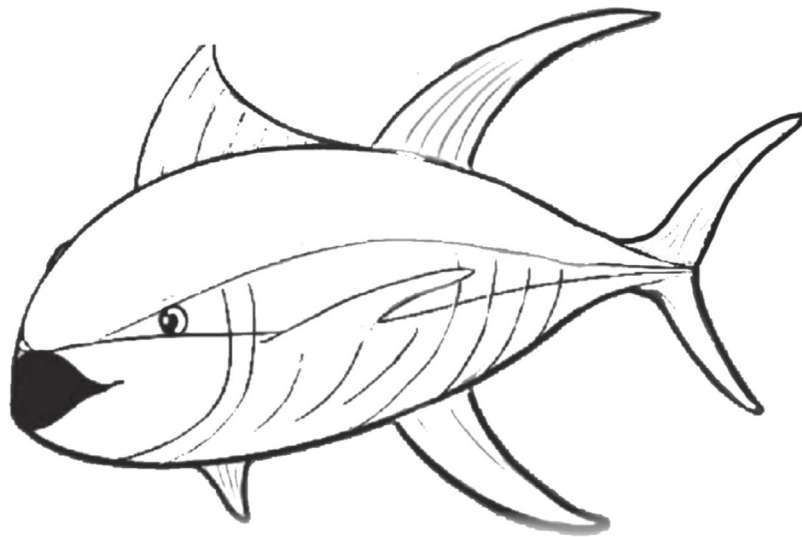


Y y yellowfin tuna
